Minutes of the Board of Studies of the Department of Sociology – 11.02.2016

The meeting of the Board of Studies in Sociology met on 11.02.2016 in the Department of Sociology at 1.30 p.m. to discuss and approve the restructured curriculum 2016 for the undergraduate and post graduate courses.

Agenda

1. To discuss and pass the syllabus for B.A. and M.A. in Sociology.

The Following members were present in the meeting. (List attached)

The meeting commenced with a silent prayer. The Head of the Department welcomed all the members and briefed them about the agenda.

As for the U.G. syllabus at present there are two packages namely Rural and Urban Package. The Rural package consists of papers on Rural Sociology, Rural Development and Non-Profit Organisations and the Urban package consists of papers on Urban Sociology, Urban Development and Corporate Social Responsibility. After serious discussions, it was decided by the members of the Board to remove the package system followed by the department and to offer individual papers namely Rural Sociology, Urban Sociology. Papers on Rural Development and Urban Development to be merged as a single paper named Urban Rural Development, Human Resource Management as skill based paper and NPO, CSR and OB to be given as optional papers. The students could choose one of them.

With regard to P.G. programme in Sociology, since M.A. is started only during this academic year, as directed by the Registrar of the University of Madras, we are strictly adhering to the University syllabus. However as the per the PG template of our college we are able to teach more than the University papers. Thus the conceived of an ID paper in consultation with the Department of Media Arts, viz, Media and Society, the syllabus of which presented here with for your perusal and consideration.

No significant alterations have been made in the content of the papers, but only updating of the references and reordering of some of the papers have been effected.

After serious deliberations and scrutiny, the syllabus of both the programmes offered by the department were passed, incorporating the relevant changes and corrections proposed by the members of the board
