INTRODUCTION

- The HOD started the Meeting with a brief introduction about the Department stating that the Economics course was started in the early 1925 and it has got its Prime place in the college.
- He expressed that there are six different kinds of students in the Department of Economics – Students who aspires for Higher Studies in Economics, Civil Services, MBA Programme, Entrepreneurs, Professors and who make use of Campus Direct Recruitment.
- The UG and PG syllabus have been framed in a holistic way by including all the above mentioned aspirants
- The HOD introduced the External Members Dr. A. Duraisamy, Associate Professor,in Economics, Madras Christian College, Tambaram, Chennai. Nominated by the Vice Chancellor of University of Madras Mr. Darshan Bhaskar, Director Padiyappa Soaps (Former Economics Student), Salem, and Mr. Anirudh Belle, Founder "YOU SPEAK INDIA" (Former Economics Student) and the current student representatives Ms. Rosy Merlin, M. Phil scholar, Ms. Nithya Jejo, II MA student and Mr. Alok Thomas Paul, III BA Economics.

UG TEMPLATE AND SYLLABUS

- The Head, Department of Economics Highlighted structure of UG Template and also requested to give suggestions for the same
- Feedback from the External Member stating that it is compulsory to do Econometrics as a major core to apply for higher studies in India and in abroad.
- **Prof. A. Duraisamy** an external member pointed out that it is not fair enough for a reputed institution like Loyola College not offering a major core paper econometrics. So, He suggested to merge statistics paper offered in the 2nd semester and Advanced quantitative methods offered in the 3rd semester as one paper called Quantitative Tools for Economics and to introduce Basic Econometrics in the 3rd semester.
- The board agreed for the above decision and stated that Basic Econometrics can be introduced in the Third semester as the Major core paper
- Operation Research will be placed in the place of Introductory econometrics as Elective subject
- Prof. Selvaraj. M suggested that there is a provision for adding one more paper in the elective subject category only for shift II since they have three sections. Hence Financial services and Social Economics will be offered in the 4th and 5th semester respectively.

• There was a detailed discussion on the UG template and the UG syllabus (Major core, Allied Papers offered by parent Department to other departments, Elective subjects, skilled based course, Internship and Major special) and the Board passed the same.

PG TEMPLATE AND SYLLABUS

- The Head, Department of Economics, highlighted the Structure of PG template
- The HOD presented the PG syllabus in detail
- There was a detailed discussion on the PG template and the PG syllabus (Major Core, Elective Subjects, Interdisciplinary Paper, Summer Training Programme and Project,) subsequently the board passed the same.
- The External members were very happy with PG syllabus and also appreciated for the new papers which are introduced like Data Analytics, and Urban Economics.

The Head, of the Department before concluding the Board of Studies meeting remarked that we the Department of Economics together keeping in mind the National trend in the field of Economics in India want to make a modest effort interms of introducing mathematical orientation in both UG and PG curriculum and to depart from the past and to set a benchmark with the new curriculum which would benefit both our UG and PG students to climb up in their career path to achieve their professional goals.

HOD thanked all the board members for their constructive suggestions and support in completing the task of restructuring both UG and PG curriculum which will be introduced from the next academic year 2016 -2017.

The retiring Head of the Department of Economics after seeking permission from the board remarked that it is his and his team's gift to the Department of Economics for its Glorious future.

The Board of Studies meeting after the vote of thanks ended at 12.30 pm. and board members had lunch in the Loyola College Hostel.

Dr. D. Sathiyavan – University Nominee, Associate Professor, Department of Econometrics, University of Madras, expressed his inability to be present for the Board of Studies due to unavoidable reason and his e-mail communication to this effect is attached herewith.

All the staff members of Shift I and Shift II were present.

Prof. B.Bhagwan Das, Head, Department of Economics, welcomed the members of the Board of Studies and briefed about the agenda for the meeting. The following deliberations were made as per the circulated agenda:

Passing the M.Phil curriculum to be implemented from 2019-20

With regard to the M.Phil curriculum restructuring, all the theory papers including Subject Specialization shall be offered during the First Semester. The Research Project alone shall be offered during the Second Semester. This resolution was passed by the Board of Studies members

Result Analysis - November 2018

Prof. S. Neeta presented the result analysis for November 2018 semester examination. She highlighted that the academic performance of PG students was consistently good over the semesters, but the poor performance of IPG in comparison with IIPG is an area of concern. The academic performance of UG students is improving over the years. But the overall passpercentage of the UG students is not impressive and after a long deliberation it was

unanimously decided to implement student centric strategies to improve the overall results of UG students.

Curriculum restructuring

Dr. ElangoParimalam presentedthe modified syllabus for the following four papers for ratification:

- 1. Data Analytics for Economists PG
- 2. Environmental Economics PG
- 3. Research Methods in Economics UG
- 4. Indian Economic Planning and Policy UG

The ratified syllabus was discussed in length and after deliberations and incorporating the suggestions from the Board of Studies members, the syllabus was passed. The same has been attached herewith.

Prof. B.Bhagwan Das introduced the new proposed template for UG as given by the Office of the Academic Deans and requested the Board of Studies members to propose Major/Allied/Elective papers to be offered during the various semesters. He also emphasized the need for passing the papers proposed for semesters I and II immediately in order to implement the same from the academic year 2019-20. However the members can propose papers to be offered during other semesters in this Board of Studies, while the proposed syllabus for those papers other than semesters I and II can be discussed and passed during the next Board of Studies meeting.

The restructured curriculum was discussed and the template was passed by the Board of Studies members and the same is attached herewith.
