

A team of trained staff accompanies the students as mentors guiding, supporting and sorting out their academic and personal issues to complete their studies successfully.


COUNSELLING CENTRE

APPLYING FOR ADMISSION

Admission into Loyola is competitive. The selection policies and admission process are unique. We welcome applicants from diverse social, cultural, economic, ethnic and geographical backgrounds.

ELIGIBILITY FACTORS

Loyola gives preference to the students from the neighbouring districts. The inclusive tradition of loyola welcomes students from other states and countries.

Women students can apply for all the Post Graduate courses and also for VISCOM, B.Com. (Honours), B.M.M. (Animation) French Lit. and B.Voc. in Under Graduate courses.

Students who have completed the Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary Course or any other course, recognized by the University of Madras as equivalent to it, are eligible for admission to the bachelor's degree course.

The applicants who have passed the following examination should submit an eligibility certificate from the University of Madras.

- Higher Secondary or equivalent examination conducted by all other State Boards except Tamil Nadu
- All degree (UG/PG) examinations conducted by any university other than University of Madras / foreign countries

The online registration process should be completed within 10 working days from the date of publication of the result of Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary Course. If the results are not published for any board before the last date of the online submission of application, then the students are asked to complete the online registration within 3 days from the date of publication of the result of those boards.

SELECTION PROCESS

INTERVIEW

At the time of interview the original documents of all certificates uploaded along with the online application should be produced for verification.

Information will be given only to those who are provisionally selected. They have to present themselves/along with parents for interview with the Principal on the date mentioned in the call-letter.

Failure to be present on the scheduled date and time will lead to cancellation of admission.

The information of selection will be sent by registered SMS and Email. It will also be posted in the registered online portal. The application status will also be available at www.loyolacollege.edu

ENTRANCE TEST

An Entrance test for all candidates applying for PG courses will be conducted and it will be followed by a personal interview. Students should produce all the original documents for verification at the time of interview.

The last date for submitting the online application for all PG courses is: 11.06.2018 (Monday).

The Entrance test for all PG courses will be conducted on 16.06.2018 (Saturday) at 9.00 a.m. in the College.

FEE PAYMENT

The provisionally selected and admitted candidates have to pay the prescribed fee at the Axis Bank - CMS counter at Loyola College campus.

WITHDRAWAL

The enrolled students are expected to complete their course of study. They may not withdraw from the college without informing the Principal

in writing. Otherwise they will be liable to pay the fee of the period for which their name remains on the rolls.


- Course Applied for: Choose one or more courses to apply to Shift-I or Shift-II separately from the list of eligible courses. The applicant can apply for more than one course in one shift or in both shifts.
- Course/s in Shift-I and Shift-II should be applied separately from the generation of application menu.
- Confirm the course/s applied for.

You can edit your entries also. If you are sure of the entries, kindly press "Apply" button.

STEP - 8: PAYMENT OF APPLICATION FEE



- The cost of each application including Processing fee is ₹ 150 for UG, ₹ 200 for PG and ₹ 500 for M.Phil.
- Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe applicants need not pay the cost of application, but only the processing fee of ₹ 123 each for UG, ₹ 158 each for PG and ₹ 500 for M.Phil. should be paid.
- You can pay the cost of application fee through Credit Card, Debit Card, Net Banking or Cash in any branch of Axis Bank (through EASY PAY) as per your choice. For EASY PAY in any branch of AXIS BANK, a challan should be generated and money should be paid.
- You are allowed to cancel the course/s applied till you pay the cost of the application/s.
- A summary is displayed in 'View application status'.
- After the Payment of application fee, application number will be generated and the status will be sent to the candidate through SMS and email.



The applicant can apply for any number of courses eligible to him/her and after payment, an application number will be created for each. The applicants are allowed to take printout of each application after the registration and payment.

NOTE TO STUDENTS
