

4. Intensive cleaning of adopted Village/Slums – 5 days may be devoted for intensive cleaning of adopted Villages/Slums.
5. Local area cleaning – The NSS units may identify 1 -2 Welfare agencies like Hospitals, Old age Homes, Orphanages, Railway station, Bus Stand etc. and dedicate their services in that area. Kindly ensure to identify 5 specific target area from the above places and carryout the cleaning activities with proper documentation – (BDA Format i.e. **Before the Activity, During the Activity, After the Activity**) **Action Photos & Video and coverage by media (Print & Electronic Media) The cleaning activities under taken should be visible and quantifiable.**
6. Organisation of rally – all NSS units will organise rallies in their respective Cities/Villages by depicting various messages of Cleanliness on Banners and placards to create awareness among the public.
7. Holding of meeting – All the NSS Units will hold a Meeting of NSS Volunteers in our campus under your Chairmanship to discuss plans of sustaining Cleanliness in the area.

In view of the above, you are requested to instruct all NSS Programme Officers of the respective Units of our college to observe **Swachhat Pakhwara** in a befitting manner by organising suitable Programmes as mentioned above.



1. The concept can be submitted by an individual or team from any institution/organization.
2. The concepts should focus on any one area (Substance abuse (Tobacco and Alcohol)/ Diet and nutrition/Physical Inactivity and Exercise/ Hygiene: Personal and Environmental).
3. Concepts that are interactive and based on activity or demonstration will be given preference.
4. Concepts that are only display in nature will not be preferred.
5. Last date for registration on or before 20th February 2018.
6. Concept notes submitted before the suggested deadline will only be considered.
7. A team of judges (experts in the focus area) will shortlist and approve concepts.
8. Only pre-approved concepts can be displayed.
9. Only reusable or recyclable materials can be used.
10. Any deviations from approved concept will be prevented from display.
11. All stalls should be installed the night before and will be inspected for deviations.
12. Inspectors will be monitoring the stalls regularly and any deviations will be summarily rejected.
13. It is the responsibility of the organization to depute presenters to explain the concept if selected during the event and they should be well versed with the concept and be able to explain the same in both English and Tamil.
14. Only 2 participants per stall will be allowed.
15. Participation certificate will be provided to all participants.
16. Outstanding submissions will be awarded at the valedictory function based on visitor's voting and Judge.


